Day-by-Day-Itinerary

Day 1 Travel to Austria

Your Alpine Winter Adventure begins with an overnight flight to Europe. [In-flight meals]

Day 2 Salzburg & Ski Resorts

Upon arrival, transfer to your four-star hotel in the city center. Free afternoon while others arrive. Meet for a welcome orientation cocktail with your local host. [In-flight meals, C]

Day 3 Salzburg & Ski Resorts

After enjoying your buffet-breakfast, board the shuttle bus to the ski resort for a whole day of skiing, snowboarding and/or après-ski activities. Return to the hotel in the evening. Salzburg Winter Adventurers may sign up for a city walking tour or explore the city on your own.

Suggested evening activities: Visit one of Salzburg's city theatres, the Mozarteum or the Salzburg Casino. [B]

Day 4 Salzburg & Ski Resorts

If you are ready to experience the next resort, hop on the bus in front of the hotel. You can hold on to your ski/snowboarding equipment until your host returns it on the last day. For non-skiers a variety of options are available. How about a visit to the Oktoberfest city of Munich or the Swarovski crystal factory in Innsbruck? Of course, there is always shopping to be done on Salzburg's Getreidegasse. Don't miss the nightlife in Mozart's city. Hidden behind ancient facades are bustling beer halls, pulsating nightclubs and other popular hangouts. [B]

Day 5 Salzburg & Ski Resorts

Can you master the slopes where the Alpine Ski World Championships take place? Try your skills at today's resort. Consider a Badgastein sleigh-ride tour, book a horse-drawn-carriage ride, go winter hiking, ice skating or cross-country skiing. This evening you may want to indulge in classical music. The Hohensalzburg Fortress features concerts on select nights of the week. Check with your host for availability and performance times. [B]

Day 6 Salzburg & Ski Resorts

If you don't feel like skiing today, explore some of the many museums Salzburg has to offer. Hohensalzburg Fortress or Mozart's birthplace are also a must see. Visit one of the many typical café houses in the city and taste one or more of their decadent pastries and have coffee with 'Schlag.' Then, consider a spa treatment and swim at the Paracelsus Pool and Spa to work it off.

Suggestions for the evening; Pub-crawling or Salzburg's famous Marionettentheater (puppet theatre). [B]

Day 7 Salzburg & Ski Resorts

Your last day to take in another one of Austria's famous ski resorts. Remember to return your ski equipment today. Check with your host about arranging an excursion if you are done skiing. Enjoy your last night in this magical city and if you haven't done so, make sure to try some of the local delicacies at any one of the traditional restaurants. [B]

INCLUSIONS/EXCLUSIONS/SUBSTITUTIONS: Packages include accommodations with breakfast daily and features described as included in this brochure. The participant is responsible for any and all other costs or expenses associated with the package. AESU reserves the right, at any time, to substitute comparable, alternative accommodations, to reasonably alter or substitute scheduled itineraries, or to do both. These prices do not include passport and, if applicable, visa fees (Depending on your nationality, you may require visas in addition to a passport to enter certain countries. You must contact appropriate consulates for details on how to obtain on your own.); airport and government taxes; beverages with meals unless indicated otherwise; laundry; personal insurance; room service; telephone charges; ski equipment and ski passes; all items of a personal nature; portage; airport transfers when a participant deviates from scheduled AESU flights or travel dates; private transportation; tipping of tour escort; and all items not specifically stated in the itinerary. **CANCELLATION POLICY:** All cancellations must be received by AESU Alumni World Travel in writing. ALL cancellations, for any reason whatsoever, will be subject to a \$300 (three hundred dollars) per person cancellation fee. Cancellation between 90-61 days of departure will result in a fee of 10% (ten percent) + \$300 (three hundred dollars) per person. Cancellation 60-31 days of departure will result in a fee of 25% (twenty-five percent) + \$300 (three-hundred dollars). Cancellation 30-16 days of departure will result in a fee of 40% (forty percent) + \$300 (three hundred dollars). Cancellation within 16 days of departure or a "no-show" at the time of departure will result in forfeiture of the entire cost of the trip: 100% (one-hundred percent). **AIRFARES** are highly restrictive, **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-ENDORSABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE** once ticketed. Once reservation is booked and paid for AESU/ Alumni World Travel reserves the right to issue tickets. Once ticketed, airfare portion is non-refundable. Cancellation of airfare reservations is subject to restrictions, regulations and additional penalties of the airlines used. Reservation changes also subject to penalties. **TRIP CANCELLATION INSURANCE** is recommended. Medical health and accident insurance is compulsory. **AIRPORT TRANSFERS & BAGGAGE:** All participants using AESU Alumni World Travel flights on regular group departure days receive airport transfers to and from Salzburg airport. Land-Only participants (providing own flight to Europe) do NOT receive airport transfers and must meet group at the first hotel after 1:00pm on program start date. All programs start in Europe ONE DAY LATER THAN the USA departure dates listed. Participants should limit themselves to one checked bag per person and one carry-on per person. Liability is clearly stated on the passenger contract. **RESPONSIBILITY:** The responsibility of AESU Alumni World Travel is limited. They act only in the capacity of agents for the passenger in all matters pertaining to accommodations, sightseeing and transportation whether by railroad, motorboat, motorcar, steamship or plane, and as such they shall not be liable for any personal injury, death, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity which may be occasioned, whether by reason of any defect in any vehicle, or through the acts or default of any company or person engaged in conveying the passenger, or in carrying out the arrangement of the tour. They can accept no responsibility for strike, war, quarantine, weather and any other natural or unnatural causes. Additional expenses, if incurred under any of these circumstances, will be borne by the tour participant. By forwarding the deposit, the passenger certifies that s/he has no physical, mental or other condition or disability that would create a hazard for him/herself or other passengers & accepts the terms of this contract. The right is reserved to decline, accept, or retain any person as a member of the tour or to cancel or alter the tour as required. If improvements in the itinerary can be made, or unforeseen conditions beyond AESU Alumni World Travel make changes necessary, they reserve the right to alter itineraries without penalty. Adventure travel, high altitudes, skiing and snowboarding involve risks about which the participant must make him/herself aware. By joining an AESU package, the participant does hereby agree that neither the participant nor his or her heirs, personal or legal representatives, or family members will bring suit or make a claim for illness, injury or death resulting from the negligence of AESU employees, officers, directors, managers, agents, contractors or affiliated organizations or the supplier of any element of the package as a result of participation in the program. Trip cancellation insurance should be purchased by the individual traveler in the event cancellation of the tour is compelled by circumstances beyond AESU's control. In the event of cancellation due to insufficient number of participants, AESU Alumni World Travel's liability shall be limited to a FULL REFUND of all payments received from applicants, except non-refundable airfare and insurance. Baggage and personal injury are at owner's risk entirely. The issuance or acceptance of vouchers or tickets shall be considered consent of the above conditions. AESU Alumni World Travel reserves the right to increase the program price in the event of cost increases due to changes in airfares, currency fluctuations or fuel surcharges. The airlines concerned and their affiliates and agents are not to be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not on board the aircrafts.
